The objectives of this assignment are:

- to rethink, revise and refine your project concepts, methodologies, themes, etc;
- to finalize a list of deliverables;
- to articulate project milestones and critical path;
- to devise concrete and specific project schedule.

At this stage, you should revise the writing that you submitted last term: to polish it up, make it clearer, add to it, etc, based on any additional research and ideation, the feedback you received at the end of last term and the feedback you are receiving during our work in class this term. You may include additional research, sources, objectives, technologies, etc. The revisions are with the intention of clarifying, refining and concretizing the project ideas and fixing its parameters. You may NOT completely change your project idea, concepts, themes and subject without my prior approval. This is a chance for revision not for starting from scratch.

Strong recommendation: Many of you are working on projects that relate to your other academic major. I strongly recommend that you consult with one or more of your professors in your other major to get their feedback on your concepts, approach and theoretical framework. In particular, if you're putting together interview questions, you should try to get some feedback on them from the profs in your other discipline that informs your project. Please reach out and seek other advice. This will only strengthen your work, it may also make it easier (you could be surprised at how much research time their comments may save you).

Please include the following in your revised proposal:

- Final project description: 250-300 words max, describes concepts, form, content, methodology & objectives
- Project milestones (deliverables): in point-form with dates
- A detailed and refined project schedule
- Annotated bibliography
- Scrapbook

Please start a new wiki page for this. Instructions will be posted on the wiki. You may copy all or parts of your last version and paste in the new page. Please follow the guideline on the wiki re the order of components.

Important Note: This proposal version will be marked on its own and in entirety. Please note that I will not mark any more of your work until you finish all parts of this proposal.
